History is evident that competencies have been developed by two main parties

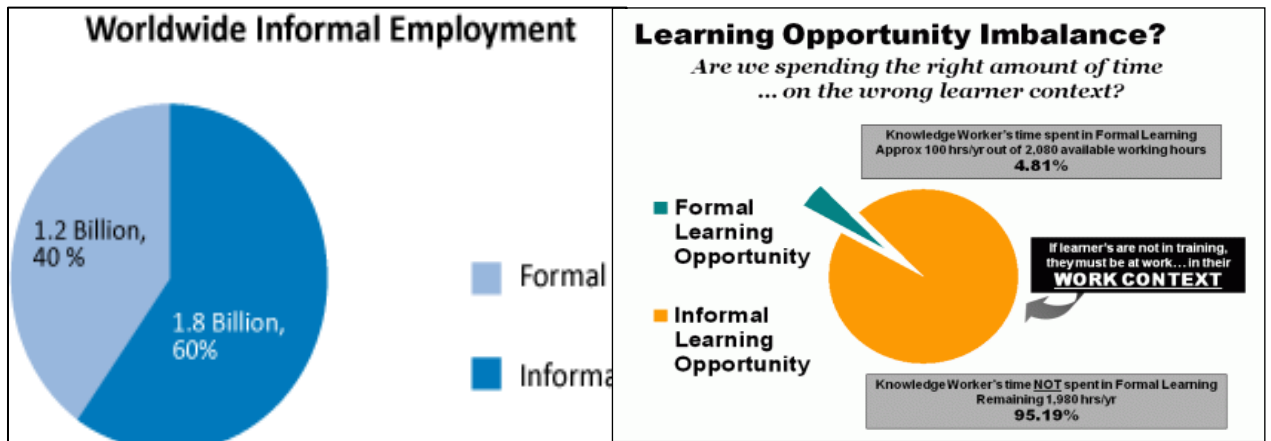


Formal education:
